With these words, Nobel Prize winner Frédéric Mistral summed up the fantastic attraction that Cassis exerts on its visitors. The small fishing port between the rocky massif of the Calanques and the majestic Cap Canaille, two extraordinary natural landscapes, is an icon of Provence and the Mediterranean. The magic begins on the small road that winds its way through vineyards and pine forests to the village. As you stroll through narrow alleyways and across small squares, past colorful fishermen's houses, you succumb to the charm for good. By the time you catch sight of the port of Cassis with its ships and inviting restaurant terraces, it's already too late: you're set for life.
